



Clean Plant Center Northwest Grapevine Introduction Nomination

CPCNW

All selections entering into the Clean Plant Center Northwest (CPCNW) Foundation Vineyard must be designated as either *Public* or *Sponsored* selections.

Public: Selections must go through the following process before being included in the program:

1. Proposals of a variety/clone submitted in writing to CPCNW by **November 1**
2. Proposals reviewed by the Northwest Foundation Block Advisory Group for approval or rejection
3. Approved selections are acquired and introduced into the CPCNW Foundation Vineyard once requirements are met

Anyone may submit a request to add a Public variety to the CPCNW Foundation Vineyard, but all requests may not meet the criteria of the Northwest Foundation Block Advisory Group. Funding for introducing and maintaining Public selections will come from sales, grants, gifts and nursery assessments. Annual deadline for submitting requests is **November 1**.

Sponsored: For a fee, a party may request introduction of a selection to the program and control the distribution of the resulting plant material. The submission process is the same as above and acceptance is subject to space availability in the Foundation Vineyard, as determined by the Northwest Foundation Block Advisory Group. Sponsored selections can be either Public or Private cultivars, but the resulting material will only be distributed with approval and direction of the sponsor.

All selections entering the CPCNW Foundation Vineyard must satisfy the same foundation certification requirements.

***Sponsored Selections Fee Structure:** \$4,000 includes complete disease testing, elimination treatment, and post-treatment testing for viruses specified by the National Clean Plant Network, and Washington and Oregon Administrative Codes. If sponsors elect for CPCNW to retain the selections in the Foundation Vineyard, these additional fees apply: initial planting fee \$150, annual maintenance fee \$500. Otherwise, a single potted vine will be returned to the sponsor once testing is complete.
